*Theme 1: Evaluation of the risk factors for foot ulceration in diabetes mellitus- a Lagos State survey*

Diabetes mellitus foot syndrome (DMFS) is a major complication of DM in Nigerians with DM. Literature has revealed that the prevalence of DMFS in Nigeria is 9% and in Lagos, Nigeria, DMFS accounts not only for 30% of all DM related deaths but is also associated with a case fatality rate of 28%. The amputation rates of DMFS in Lagos are as high as 40%.

Diabetes mellitus foot syndrome is a cause of reduced quantity and quality of life in Nigeria and contributes to about a third of all DM related deaths in the country. Hitherto, there has been no program addressing this all important complication of DM on a large scale. Foot care teams are absent in the hospitals and there is a disconnect between healthcare workers (orthopaedic surgeons, nurses, diabetologists and educators) who attend to persons with the diabetic foot

Preventive healthcare is an aspect of the diabetic foot that is largely ignored by healthcare professionals who run busy DM clinics. The technical know-how and capacity to offer preventive healthcare is lacking in the majority of the healthcare providers.

The project was designed to reduce the substantial contribution of DMFS to the huge disease burden of DM in the state. To this end the overarching objective was to evaluate for neuropathy and peripheral vascular disease in the Study subjects and determine the frequency of occurrence of these potential risk factors. Our findings are geared towards instituting preventive measures

*Theme 2: Thyroid dysfunction in persons with diabetes mellitus*

Diabetes mellitus and thyroid dysfunction (TD) are the two most common endocrine disorders in clinical practice. Screening for TD in DM is justified because most patients can be asymptomatic and the import of the detection of TD may lie in the fact that its presence may aggravate the presence of cardiovascular risk.

*Theme 3: Thyroid antibodies in type 2 diabetes mellitus*

This aim of this Study was to compare the prevalence of thyroid dysfunction and autoimmunity in type 2 diabetes in age and sex matched control subjects

*Theme 4: Hyperprolactinaemia and the metabolic syndrome in diabetes mellitus.*

Novel cardiovascular risk factors are being unearthed and one of these which has not been widely studied is hyperprolactinaemia. Prolactin is a pituitary hormone essential for various physiological function in the body. The metabolic syndrome which is a cluster of cardiovascular risk factors which is often associated with type 2 diabetes mellitus. An observational study among patients with erectile dysfunction showed an association between low PRL with MetS and type 2 DM. We therefore aim to investigate potential associations between prolactin, MetS and type 2 DM.
