Lagos State University College of Medicine: A Journey of Excellence and Growth

The illustrious journey of **Lagos State University College of Medicine (LASUCOM)** as a great citadel of learning began on February 9, 1999, when it was inaugurated by the Lagos State Government.

The historical background of the college can be traced back to **March 1987**, when the then Vice Chancellor of Lagos State University, **Prof. Afolabi Olumide**, initiated an advisory board to establish the Lagos State University College of Medicine, as recommended by the Tertiary Education Review Committee. Although the Advisory Board submitted its report in 1987, the challenges faced by the university at the time delayed the establishment of the college.

Successive administrators, including **Prof. Jadesola Akande** and **Prof. Enitan Bababunmi**, during their respective tenures as Vice-Chancellors, made efforts to establish the College of Medicine but were hindered by significant underfunding.

In February 1997, when **Prof. Fatiu Akesode** assumed the role of Vice-Chancellor, he sought the support of the then Lagos State Military Administrator, **Col. Muhammed Buba Marwa (rtd)**, in a second attempt to establish the College of Medicine, which finally came to fruition in July 1997. The report of the Advisory Committee was presented to the military administrator in August 1997, and most of the committee's recommendations were accepted.

The MBBS program commenced on **February 9, 1999**, with an initial cohort of fifty-two (52) students. Today, LASUCOM stands as a preeminent medical institution dedicated to excellence in education, research, and patient care, widely recognized as the premier medical college in Nigeria.

Over the course of two and a half decades, the college has witnessed remarkable growth. It expanded from offering only the **MBBS program** to encompassing additional programs, which include Undergraduate Programs (**Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Dental Surgery, Bachelor of Nursing Science, BSc in Physiology, BSc in Pharmacology, Doctor of Physiotherapy, Medical Laboratory Science, Radiography and Radiological Science, Doctor of Pharmacy**) and Postgraduate Programs (**MSc, PhD in Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Occupational Health, Occupational medicine, Public Health, Clinical Sciences & Basic Clinical Sciences**).

The college also expanded from having two faculties to six faculties which include the Faculties of **Basic Medical Sciences, Basic Clinical Sciences, Clinical Sciences, Dentistry, Allied Health Sciences and Pharmacy**.

It transformed from a single-story building as its primary facility to the addition of four more buildings, which include the Facilities Building, Storey Building, Glass House, FBMS/FBCS Building and the TETFUND Building. The college also expanded its accommodations, evolving from having only one hostel building to having three (3) hostel buildings.

The college boasts an increased number of laboratories, including the addition of clinical skills laboratories. Notably, the college stands as the sole state university in Nigeria to offer a **Bachelor of Dental Surgery program**.
